THE SECRET PLACE—A PLACE OF SUPERNATURAL BREAKTHROUGH

God's presence is manifested to us in the secret place of prayer, where we come to know our heavenly Father. As we pray, God reveals Himself to us, and we are drawn to Him in ever greater ways. He places us under His care as His special treasure and part of His very heart.

The result is that *prayer in God's presence generates power*. When someone prays in the secret place, they are empowered to go and pour out that power upon other people for healing, deliverance, and miracles. Although power is our inheritance as children of God, we can only use it legally, in a spiritual sense, through prayer that is part of an intimate relationship with the Father.

Many people are being prevented from knowing God and accessing His presence and power for one reason—they have never developed a consistent prayer life. When continuity in prayer ceases, momentum in the Spirit is halted. But when we pray continuously, we generate a momentum that produces a prayer “accumulation” in the Spirit that builds to the point of breakthrough and victory.

This *Supernatural Breakthrough Journal* will be a tremendous blessing to you by helping you establish a lifestyle of continually walking in God's

presence—boldly moving in the supernatural and bringing transformation to your life and the world around you. God answers the prayers of everyone who prays according to His will. Don't ever let yourself become discouraged if the answers to your prayers have not yet manifested. Keep praying, keep obeying, keep deepening your faith and trust, and keep building momentum—until you achieve an accumulation of prayers igniting your breakthrough!

Throughout this journal, you will find spiritual truths and principles of breakthrough drawn from a number of my books, with corresponding prayers and Scriptures. Use these as a starting point each day for entering God's presence, challenging your faith, and operating in the realm of the Spirit as you move from natural to supernatural. Record your personal prayers, revelations, and supernatural breakthroughs in these pages. Let them be a testimony of God's great love and power!

Each day, when you pray, remember to focus on God's priorities—what He says in His Word about His great purposes for the world, especially in these momentous end times. His priorities are that His kingdom be manifested on earth as it is in heaven; that people be saved, filled with His Spirit, healed, delivered, and commissioned to bring His gospel throughout the world; that miracles, signs, and wonders be demonstrated by His people, confirming the reality of the kingdom gospel; that families be reconciled and live together in love and peace; that the nations acknowledge His name; that His church be sanctified as the bride of Christ; and that *“the earth... be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea”* (Habakkuk 2:14).

God wants you to have a part in these great purposes. Jesus has called us to continue His ministry on earth, saying, *“He that believes on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go to My Father”* (John 14:12). Those who believe will do “greater works.” It all begins in the presence of God—surrendering to His will, being filled with His Spirit, exercising the faith He has given you, and obeying His leading. I declare that remarkable breakthroughs and supernatural demonstrations will be manifested through your life, and that you will fill these pages with testimonies and praises to the glory of God!
