### **PREFACE**

here is a sea of negative books on the market about Mike Pence. Due to the positive nature of this one and the timing of its release, some will say that the vice president or those associated with him asked me to write it or influenced me in some other way. I want to set the record straight from the onset.

In 2006, I wrote and released *The Faith of Condoleezza Rice*, knowing it might be years before I published another book. My husband and I were undergoing fertility treatments and vowed that if I got pregnant, I'd take a few years off of working outside the home to raise my children until they were in school full-time. Well, I did get pregnant and we had two children in the span of two-and-a-half years.

In early summer 2017, with two kids getting ready to start school again, I prayed and asked God to send me a new book contract; it was time to get back into the thick of things. Two weeks later, I dreamt that I was to write *The Faith of Mike Pence*. The truth is, neither he nor his faith were even on my radar. I got out of bed and began doing a little research. I wrote a book proposal for different publishers and began to accumulate a list of people I hoped to interview.

Within the next couple of days, I sent my proposal to the publishers of my book on Condoleezza's faith. They got back to me right away to say they weren't interested.

The worst part of an author's life is courting publishers. It literally drains the life out of you. So I prayed to God, "If writing this book is really Your will, please send the right publisher to me."

The *next day*, I received an e-mail from Christine Whitaker, the author liaison at Whitaker House. I had sent her a fiction book proposal a year earlier and she was just getting back to me. She wasn't interested in *that* proposal, but she did invite me to send any non-fiction proposals I had. I quickly sent her my proposal for *The Faith of Mike Pence*. Within days, Christine let me know Whitaker House was interested. In the realm of book publishing, getting a contract within days is unheard of—it simply never happens.

I put a request in to the White House to interview the vice president and his wife. I asked for their permission to interview their families and closest friends. While I waited for an answer, I prayed and asked God to give me favor by opening the doors. In the meantime, I just kept doing research, interviewing people, and writing the book in faith.

As I proceeded, I had no idea what was going on behind the scenes. Without informing me, my requests for interviews and cooperation were denied. Unaware of this denial, I kept praying in faith and asked others to join me. I had faith that if God had really asked me to write this book, He'd blow open the necessary doors to get it done.

One afternoon as I was in my car, I received an unexpected call from a man who introduced himself as Jay C. Steger, a fellow believer and the vice president's best friend. He hadn't even been on my radar, let alone on my list of people to interview. Jay told me that although my request for the vice president's approval and assistance in this book was initially denied, he had since had a change of heart. Jay would connect me to the "inner-circle" of the vice president's friends to interview—and possibly family members as well.

As I interviewed different people, God gave me favor and they began referring to me other people to interview, opened doors to those who were often reluctant to speak, and encouraged the vice president and his people to participate in this project to the fullest extent possible.

While many participated, there was some resistance from others. The vice president, his family, and those closest to him had been burnt

horribly by the media in the past, with their comments taken out of context, twisted, or used as weapons. I was facing an uphill battle. Yet I believe in the power of prayer and kept on storming the gates of heaven, asking for God to open the doors and give me favor.

Ultimately, I ended up with more than fifty interviews with many other people, some of whom wished to remain anonymous. While everyone supported this book and had great things to say about the vice president, not everyone shared his religious convictions or political views. This in itself revealed a lot about who he is as a man and Christian, as well as his ability to connect with people.

One afternoon, I had a unique interview with Rex Elsass, founder and CEO of the Strategy Group Company. Rex is a dear friend of the vice president's and his company has produced all of Mike Pence's campaign ads since he won his first congressional campaign. Rex and I connected spiritually and God showed him my heart for this project. It was clear to him that I wasn't writing a "tell-all" or out to hurt the vice president, but to share the truth about who he is as a man, husband, father, politician, and Christian. What I can only believe is a miracle from the hand of God, Rex became an avid supporter and, on several occasions, personally advocated on my behalf directly to the vice president to participate with his wife and family. While awaiting the vice president's response, Rex and his assistant, R. J. Richmond, linked arms with me in prayer and faith that God would indeed open the necessary doors to the West Wing at the White House. Miraculously, He did.

I'm not under the illusion that everyone who reads this book will be in agreement with the vice president's political views. I must point out, however, that this is not a book about politics, but about Mike Pence's faith and how it directly affects the rest of his life. As he likes to say, "I'm a Christian, conservative, and Republican—in that order."

Many people who do not support Mike's spiritual views will find ways to mock him or twist comments and stories about him. It saddens me that we live in a country where we strongly advocate for religious freedom, yet take offense and become angry with those who don't share our views. Regardless of one's religious beliefs, if we are mature, reasonable people, we should respect anyone who lives by their convictions as Mike Pence does.

My overall goal with this book is not to set the vice president up as a spiritual hero, but to show the heart of the real man—as a Christian, husband, father, and politician. In doing so, I tried to allow his own words and those of his family, friends, and colleagues tell his story while I served as a conduit to weave it together. My prayer is that it inspires, encourages, and challenges you.
