INTRODUCTION

The God we know through Christ Jesus is a God of promise. His promises are unmerited blessings. Some are conditional, some unexplainable, but all are a result of God's grace.

His promises are guaranteed through the total victory that Christ won for us. In Christ alone, we find fulfillment of each promise, and in Him we become recipients of His grace.

As a believer in Jesus Christ, you are a child of God and an heir to all His precious promises. Like any inheritance you might receive, you must acknowledge and claim these promises before they can become effective in your life.

This book contains God's will and testament to you. It lists your inheritance: the blessings and gifts you are entitled to as God's child.

A written will must sometimes be read repeatedly in order for a person to actually comprehend the significance of all that has been inherited. This is also true of God's Word. As you meditate on God's promises, the reality of all He wants to give you will saturate your spirit. This will give you confidence to believe and claim each promise as your own.

Some legal documents have qualifying clauses written in fine print. In the same way, some of God's promises have certain conditions that must be met before they will be granted. As you study each promise carefully, take note of any qualifying conditions. You may need to make some changes in your life in order to meet God's requirements and receive His blessings. But don't be discouraged. Your faithful Father has promised to help you and change you by His Spirit.

As a loving Father, God wants to give His children good things. He has left us an inheritance—a spiritual, physical, and personal treasury of blessings. When you reach out and claim what the Father has so lovingly provided for you, great joy fills His heart.

What do you need today? Healing, peace, protection, hope? Begin reading this book at your greatest point of need, and take hold of God's promises. Acknowledge them as your inheritance, claim them as your own, and receive them into your life.

KEEP HIS PROMISES

1. *He is faithful that promised.* (Hebrews 10:23)
2. *Faithful is He that calls you, who also will do it.*
(1 Thessalonians 5:24)
3. *God is not a man, that He should lie; neither the son of man, that He should repent: has He said, and shall He not do it? or has He spoken, and shall He not make it good?* (Numbers 23:19)
4. *I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it.* (Isaiah 46:11)
5. *As for God, His way is perfect: the word of the LORD is tried.* (Psalm 18:30)

6. *Nevertheless My lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor allow My faithfulness to fail. My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of My lips.* (Psalm 89:33–34)
7. *For all the promises of God in [Jesus Christ] are yea, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God by us.* (1 Corinthians 1:20)
8. *For the LORD is a God of judgment: blessed are all they that wait for Him.* (Isaiah 30:18)

9. *For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and His ears are open to their prayers.* (1 Peter 3:20)
10. *The righteous cry, and the LORD hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles.* (Psalm 34:17)
11. *This is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His will, He hears us: and if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him.* (1 John 5:14–15)
