CHAPTER 1

YOU CAN MANIFEST ABUNDANCE

“Then God blessed them and said, ‘Be fruitful and multiply...’”

—Genesis 1:28 (NLT)

SUPERNATURAL MYSTERIES 101

Imagine that you are a detective who is seeking to solve a mystery. To do so, you need a unique mindset that can see both the big picture and the fine details that unlock the secrets to the puzzle. You also need compelling evidence on which to base your conclusions.

It is the same way for us when we seek to uncover the supernatural mysteries that God has given in His Word and revealed through His Spirit. And one vital area of God’s supernatural mysteries concerns how to live in *unlimited abundance*.

As “spiritual detectives,” we first need to step back and see the whole scene: What is the environment of divine provision? What are the foundational truths that apply to all supernatural mysteries of abundance? The answers will set us on the right path to discovery.

Second, we need to hone in on the fine details of some specific divine mysteries. What further clues will unlock their secrets? These fine details will emerge as we dig deeper to discover additional scriptural truths and principles about divine abundance.

Finally, we need to identify clear evidence of the laws of God's abundance in action. Our confirmation will come in the biblical record and in testimonies of the outworking of God's supernatural provision in people's lives today.

Together, all of these perspectives will enable us to enter into the tremendous wealth God has provided to bless us, people around us, and the world.

In this book, I share revelations concerning seven divine mysteries of unlimited abundance so that you can begin manifesting abundance in your life. These revelations, based on God's Word, will be life-shifting for you—if you listen, believe, and walk in the divine instructions they provide.

In chapter 1, we begin by exploring the biblical “big picture.” We will discover spiritual principles of abundance that are the setting for all seven divine mysteries so that, when you reach the end of this book, you will have gained a comprehensive understanding of what it means to live an abundant life in Christ and know how to put these principles into practice. Without these foundational principles, you won't be able to move on to the fine details of unlocking each individual mystery. But when you establish these truths in your life, you will be able to live in the reality of divine abundance.

THE BIBLICAL “BIG PICTURE” OF ABUNDANCE

ABUNDANCE COMES FROM HEAVEN

To begin to understand the unlimited abundance God wants to give us, let's look at a familiar story from the Bible with new eyes—the eyes of a spiritual detective—and then see how God is still working His boundless abundance in a parallel way today.

Once, a great crowd followed Jesus into a sparsely populated place to hear more of His teachings, and when it came time to eat, there was

nowhere for them to obtain food. The people's hunger moved the heart of Jesus. The disciples reported that a little boy had a few loaves of bread and two pieces of fish. (See John 6:8–9.)

*[Jesus] said, "Bring them here to Me." Then He commanded the multitudes to sit down on the grass. And He took the five loaves and the two fish, and **looking up to heaven**, He blessed and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitudes. So they all ate and were filled, and they took up twelve baskets full of the fragments that remained. Now those who had eaten were about five thousand men, besides women and children.*

(Matthew 14:18–21 NKJV)

Jesus looked to heaven, not to earth, for supernatural provision. He wasn't looking in the natural; He was looking in the Spirit. And that's a key for us too. If all you see is lack, if there is poverty on every side, then it's time to look to heaven. Focus your eyes on the Author and the Finisher of your faith. (See Hebrews 12:2.) Doing so will begin to train you to see the big spiritual picture when it comes to receiving abundance.

After Jesus had looked to heaven, He blessed those few pieces of food, broke them, and gave them to His disciples. It was then up to the disciples to distribute the food, giving a portion to each person in that great multitude. Amazingly, everyone ate and was filled, and still they gathered up twelve full baskets of leftovers. I believe those twelve baskets represent every month of the year for us. In God's Word, we are promised His divine blessing in every season of life:

*They are like trees planted along the riverbank, **bearing fruit each season**. Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do.*

(Psalm 1:3 NLT)

No one had a way to make an official count that day, but those who had eaten were about five thousand men, not including the women and children who had accompanied them to hear Jesus teach.

Jesus had started with five small loaves of bread and two fish. It has been estimated that, to feed that many people and have food left over, it would have required about twenty thousand small loaves of

bread common in that day and thousands of fish. What a great, creative, supernatural miracle of abundance from heaven! And it began with Jesus's loving concern for the needs of the people.

OVERFLOWING SPAGHETTI

The same type of heavenly abundance is available to us today when we look to heaven for our provision. Once, my wife, Janet, and I were with a ministry team in the Canadian Arctic in a northern village called Purvirnituk (POV for short), an Inuit community. We stayed in a hotel called the Novalinga, which was about the size of a small house. Each bedroom had the square footage of a medium-sized closet, so that when we opened the door to enter our room, we practically stumbled onto the single bed. Although the room was small, it had a little shelf where we could put some of our belongings, and we were thankful for the accommodations.

Along with Janet and me, a second ministry couple and another preacher were staying there. One day, after the morning meeting, we went back to the hotel, and Janet and the other pastor's wife decided to make some spaghetti for lunch.

The Inuits are very generous people, and we love them and their culture. What is theirs is yours, without question. In their northern communities, there is no need to knock on someone's door. You can just go right in, sit down at their table, fellowship with them, and eat their food.

As we were finishing our lunch preparations, in walked ten or twelve of the Inuit leaders, who were ready for lunch. What should we do? We had prepared only enough for ourselves, but we could not deny the others. We quickly decided to pray a prayer of multiplication over that food. We could think of no other option. There was no nearby store to run to and buy more food, and tradition demanded that everybody be fed.

We didn't need to feed five thousand men, plus women and children, as Jesus did, but we did need to feed about another dozen people! I actually like it when God puts us in these situations where we cannot turn to the natural but have to depend upon the supernatural. It is in such moments when we see miracles happen. If we try to work out

a situation with our own ability, we miss the manifestation of God's ability. We miss His miraculous provision simply because we rely on ourselves.

Nowhere in the Bible does it say, "Trust in your own ability." In fact, it says just the opposite. We are not to trust in our own understanding. In everything, we are to lean on God, putting our faith in His matchless proficiency, trusting Him for His unlimited abundance. (See Proverbs 3:5–6.) God is more than able to do whatever it is that we need Him to do. He is more than enough—and He didn't disappoint us that day.

After we had prayed, we started dishing out the spaghetti. Everybody had enough, and we were all completely satisfied. The Inuit pastors were delighted that we had prepared such a wonderful banquet for them. To God be all the glory!

OUR GOD IS THE GOD OF ABUNDANCE

One of the truths I want you to deeply capture in your spirit is that our God is the God of abundance. The idea of living an overflowing life filled with every good and wonderful provision isn't the stuff of legends or fairytales. This idea comes directly from God Himself. He is the God of abundance, and the Scriptures prove it! Take, for example, these wonderful truths:

- The earth and everything in it belong to God. (See Psalm 24:1.)
- All the silver and gold belong to Him. (See Haggai 2:8.)
- God is the Rancher of all ranchers; all the animals are His. (See Psalm 50:10.)
- God's greatness is unlimited. (See Psalm 145:3.)
- *"Every good and every perfect gift"* comes from Him. (See James 1:17.)
- God oversees an innumerable host of angels. (See Revelation 5:11.)

And the list could go on.

When we think about abundance, the very first thing that should come to our minds is God. Everything about God is grand, overflowing, plentiful, and filled with abundance. In the Word, we're reminded, *"And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have*

everything you need and plenty left over to share with others” (2 Corinthians 9:8–9 nlt). God is our true source of abundance!

ABUNDANCE FOR EVERY NEED

When we understand where our provision comes from, we can receive supernatural abundance in all areas of our lives—spiritual, physical, emotional, and intellectual—whenever we are in need and whenever we require resources to do all that God has called us to do.

When Janet and I were newlyweds, we lived in San Diego, California. At one point, our funds were quite low. We had only fifteen dollars in our bank account, and we were scraping together our coins to buy little things we needed. One day, we went to a meeting at our church and were impressed by God to contribute to the offering. At the close of the meeting, my good friend Paul Burke wanted a soda, and he asked me if I had enough change to lend him. I didn’t really think I did, but acting out of instinct, I reached into my pocket and was very surprised to feel some paper money there. I definitely knew it hadn’t been there before. “Wow!” I thought to myself, “I have a dollar.”

When I pulled out the money to hand it to Paul, I was amazed to see that it was a one hundred dollar bill. God had supplied that money for me. No one else had put it there. I certainly would have felt the hand of anyone reaching so deeply into my pocket! This was God’s creative glory at work to bring forth abundance in our finances. We thanked God and rejoiced in this heaven-sent money miracle.

I’m not saying that God is a counterfeiter; He doesn’t counterfeit anything. But He knows where all money is to be found. It might be hidden under some floorboards. It might be laid up in a long-neglected attic. It might be buried somewhere under the sea. It might come from another very unexpected source. In fact, the Bible says that the wealth of the wicked is laid up for the righteous—meaning those who are in Christ. (See Proverbs 13:22.) Those who are focused on the things of God and are worshipping Him wholeheartedly have blessings coming from the heavenly realm. Our God of abundance knows how to send it to us.

God is an ever-increasing God. His glory is expanding every day, and He wants you to experience unlimited abundance in your life

right now, here on earth. Contrary to popular belief, true abundance is not just about wealth accumulation. It is actually more about *flow*—God’s provision flowing *to* you so that it can flow *through* you. It is about having plenty to meet your own spiritual, emotional, and physical needs, with enough left over to meet the needs of others around you. In this way, your life will be encompassed by the riches of His glory. God desires to bring us into this abundance of His goodness so we can share that abundance with others.

ABUNDANCE IS A COMMAND: “BE FRUITFUL AND MULTIPLY”

To understand the full biblical picture of supernatural abundance, we need to identify when and where the principle of abundance was introduced on earth. We need to investigate God’s purposes in creation:

Then God blessed [Adam and Eve] and said, “Be fruitful and multiply.”
(Genesis 1:28 NLT)

Do you realize that the very first divine instruction given to humanity was all about manifesting abundance? “*Be fruitful and multiply*” was not just a suggestion—it was a command. God was speaking to Adam and Eve, our spiritual parents, and essentially telling them, “Whatever I’ve given to you has been given with the responsibility to recognize its importance and to steward it in the correct way, handling it carefully so it will continue to grow, increase, and expand. In this way, you’ll never live in lack.”

If you think this instruction was given to Adam and Eve alone, you only need to read the Scriptures a little further to discover that God spoke the same commandment again to Noah and his family in Genesis 8:17 and 9:1, 7 and to the Israelites in Leviticus 26:9.

When God says something once, we should listen. When He says something twice, we better get ready. But if God says something

three or more times, we must realize that He's very serious about the matter—and it's time for us to listen and obey! God is very concerned about your well-being. His first priority is your spiritual wellness; but beyond that, He also desires for you to manifest abundance in the realms of your soul and body (see 3 John 1:2), "being fruitful and multiplying."

ABUNDANCE IS A GIFT: "POWER TO GET WEALTH"

The big picture continues as we move forward in God's relationship with the Israelites and see Him reminding His people that their power to gain wealth was supernatural—it came from Him and was directly related to His covenant with them:

And you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. (Deuteronomy 8:18 NKJV)

I love this Scripture passage from Deuteronomy because it teaches us the secret to being successful in all areas of life. Wealth is available to us. We just need to learn how to access it. I see this theme throughout the Scriptures. I call the process "manifesting abundance," and you may call it something else, but there is an entire realm of superabundance just waiting for you and me to explore it and put it to work. God wants to give you the power to gain wealth—in the fullest sense of that word. He wants to show you how to increase and multiply in many areas of your life. In these days, He is opening untapped realms of supernatural abundance to us. Why not jump into this glory flow!

ABUNDANCE IS ACCESSED THROUGH ABIDING AND RECEIVING

As we survey the unfolding scene of supernatural abundance that God reveals for us in His Word, we see that when we abide in God's presence, we can access His divine power to increase and multiply and gain wealth. As long as Adam and Eve remained in fellowship with God, they lived in the fullness of that abundance. As long as the Israelites stayed in right relationship with the Lord, they could receive the power to gain wealth in accordance with the covenant He had established with them. That is why He told them, "*You shall remember the LORD your God*" (Deuteronomy 8:18). But when Adam and Eve,

and later the Israelites, moved away from their relationships with God, their ability to increase, multiply, and get wealth drastically diminished or disappeared.

In the New Testament, Jesus taught that we need to stay in the Vine or we won't be able to bear fruit:

Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can you, except you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches: He that abides in Me, and I in him, the same brings forth much fruit: for without Me you can do nothing. (John 15:4–5)

Without an ongoing relationship with Jesus, without being in fellowship with the Father, we “*can do nothing*,” and this includes experiencing divine multiplication. But with Jesus, with the Father, all things are possible, including supernatural abundance! (See, for example, Mark 9:23.)

In the past, God has done a lot for all of us, but I believe that He is now releasing a very special impartation, a very special gift—a release of deeper understanding and operation of His love and care for us all. Far too often, we walk in the natural, or in what we can see and understand. Many people fear anything new, insisting on staying in the areas they are already familiar with. But God wants to catch us up into the wonder of His glory where we can begin to experience what we have never seen before and what has no human explanation. Then we will decree the things that God Himself has spoken to us. They won't have been spoken by any man or woman, but rather will have come directly from heaven. When we align ourselves with what God has spoken, suddenly, anything is possible. In God, there is no lack, loss, depletion, or decline. Rather, there is all-sufficiency. In the realms of His glory, there is a fullness of all things.

We enter into God's glory realm through our love, worship, faith, obedience, and service toward Him. As children of God, we can become bold and ask Him for supernatural miracles in areas where we have experienced difficulty or lack in the past. We can ask Him to invade our circumstances, to invade our life situations, and to reveal His glory in the midst of them. He is ready to do it. We just need to

give Him permission to upset the daily routine of our lives and let His glory flow from heaven to earth. Then we need to take hold of our portion as it flows down from the throne. In those moments when His glory flows from heaven to earth, healing and other blessings can come to us in Jesus's mighty name.

As I emphasized previously, God's abundance can manifest in every area of our lives. For example, when doctors have spoken negative words, we can hold on to God's positive word that says, "*By His stripes we are healed*" (Isaiah 53:5 NKJV). And when we hold tight, healing will flow. If you need healing, just reach up into the spirit realm right now and pull down whatever it is you need. You must interact with the realm of glory. God won't force it on you. Pull it down. His healing is yours right now, in Jesus's mighty name. The miracle you have been needing is yours right now. Receive it.

You may need a miracle in your business. Just reach into the glory realm, grab hold of the miracle you need, and pull it down right now. Do it in Jesus's name.

"Is it all that easy?" some might ask.

Yes, it's just that easy. God's manifest abundance is there for you to access. Say, "What God has promised me belongs to me," and let it be yours.

You may need a miracle for your family, for a relationship, or for a difficult situation. Say to the Lord, "I am reaching up for what You have already provided for me, and I receive it now! You are wonderful, so I take hold of the fullness of Your wonder."

You may need to access the realms of God's glory for someone else's need. In the glory, you can receive an impartation for your family members, your friends, or others to whom the Lord sends you to minister. As you lift your hands into the realms of glory, those hands are being filled with healing power. There will be a transference of the healing anointing upon you. Reach up and take what you need and carry it to others. As we dare to access God's glory realms, He may perform creative miracles, such as restoring minds damaged by Alzheimer's and other forms of dementia. In exchange, He will offer us the most wonderful mind of all—the very mind of Christ.

If you stay in the Spirit long enough, your hands may actually begin to shimmer and glow with a golden glory. That golden glory speaks of the healings and miracles God will do through you in the days ahead. You will be receiving a new impartation of glory; and from that day on, God will bless the works of your hands. God is saying to you today, "Come all the way into My glory so that My glory may come all the way into you and begin to flow out through you."

Abide in Jesus. Stay in the glory. Receive God's abundant life for you and others.

Are you ready? Today, you must declare, "I am ready to move forward. I know I will not move in the same way I have moved in the past or do the same things I have been doing. I am ready for the 'new thing' God is doing in my life." (See Isaiah 43:19.)

ABUNDANCE COMES THROUGH SURRENDER

Living in the glory involves another foundational principle of abundance: we must surrender everything of ourselves to God in order to receive all that He has for us and all that He wants to pour out through us. When you offer your whole self to God as a "*living sacrifice*" (Romans 12:1), you become a channel for divine blessings to flow through your life to others. And, perhaps more than in any other way, God uses our hands to manifest and extend those blessings.

YIELDING YOUR HANDS

Let me ask you a question: where is God? Is He far off somewhere? Is He in some distant place? While His throne is in heaven, He is everywhere. (See, for example, Psalm 139:7-12.) But most wondrous of all, the moment we receive Christ, God lives inside us! (See John 14:23.) I am the "Joshua Mills" expression of Jesus Christ on the earth, and you

are a unique expression of Jesus Christ too. If you believe God dwells inside you, and not just in heaven—and you're right, He does—then where are His hands? We must realize that He often uses *our* hands to minister to the world. As you surrender to Him in the glory, your hands become the very hands of God, reaching out to bless others. You were created to live in the glory realm, and God wants to release His glory and abundance through you to many other people.

God's creative glory resides within you through His Spirit, and He will release that creative glory through your hands. Let's take this point a step further. We know that God has said He has given us the power to get wealth. (See Deuteronomy 8:18; Ecclesiastes 5:19.) If you receive that power, you will begin to do things you've never done before. Your hands will become supernatural portals for God's power to flow out through you, releasing divine creativity connected with receiving abundance in all spheres of life.

In my experience, creative direction from heaven can come to you as clear as a map to follow. Take hold of it. It has the answers to questions you've been asking. It contains clear solutions for problems you've been facing.

Not long ago, during a seven-city ministry tour, I was ministering in Tulsa, Oklahoma. One night, as I stood behind the pulpit, I was somewhat surprised to see a very tall angel directly in front of me. The other people in attendance couldn't see him—although both pastors who were present later mentioned to me that they were aware of an angelic presence. However, I could see this angel strongly in my spirit. He was dressed in white, luminescent garments. I had seen many angels appear in this way before, but what really struck me about his presence and surprised me was the object he was holding.

In his hands, he held a large, long scroll that had an ancient appearance to it. He opened it, and I could see that it was a map of directions. Although I couldn't quite decipher all the details on this map, I instantly knew in my spirit that God was showing me the future path He had already prepared for me, my family, and our ministry. This map was being supernaturally downloaded to me. God was bringing me spiritual and natural clarity for the journey ahead. This revelation brought great encouragement to my spirit.

Later that evening, I shared these details with Janet. The next day, while we were driving to Texas, we were both shocked when we called one of our spiritual mentors, Momma Billie Deck, because, without any knowledge of what had happened the night before, she said, “I see God giving you a map of directions. He’s downloading it to your spirit. He’s making a way.” Yes! That is exactly what He was doing for us—and I believe He’s doing the same for you right now, even as you read this book. You might not see a vision of a scroll, but God is birthing something in your spirit. Reach up and take it. Say, “Yes, Lord!”

I’m talking about your receiving new inventions, new blueprints, new patterns. God will release heavenly “scrolls” with instructions for you and others to follow. Take hold of those supernatural instructions and run with them, and you will surely prosper.

This touch from heaven enables you to do what you have long known you were called to do but couldn’t accomplish in your own ability. God Himself will unfold revelation after revelation to you, enabling you to know and understand what you have never known or understood before. This will allow you to step through new doors that will open for you. To others, the results will be unexplainable.

PURIFYING YOUR HANDS

I want you to truly recognize that your hands were made for creative glory—for blessing and abundance. These days, our hands do a lot of “speaking.” I don’t just mean through sign language. I’m talking about using our hands to text, to email, or to type on a tablet or laptop. Such practices are part of our modern society, and God is about to revolutionize what comes forth from your hands through these avenues and in many other ways. But for this to happen, our hands need to be purified, spiritually speaking. This enables us to stay in the glory.

Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in His holy place? He that has clean hands, and a pure heart; who has not lifted up his soul to vanity, nor sworn deceitfully. (Psalm 24:3–4)

Your hands were not created for *taking* nearly as much as they were created for *giving out*. Too often, taking involves a violation, leaving someone else with loss. Your hands were not made for greed. God

didn't create you just to take from others. Your hands were made for giving!

Even the receiving we do with our hands is creatively abundant if we are in the glory. When we receive from God or other people what the Lord has established for us to receive, we don't leave Him or His servants with loss. In such a situation, what others extend to us is what God has ordained for our lives all along. Therefore, when you receive from the hands of others, you make a way for their blessing as well.

Needless to say, when we give, we make a way for our own blessing too. May the Lord use our hands in greater and greater ways to give, to bless, and even to receive.

YOUR HANDS ARE MADE FOR CREATIVE GLORY, MADE FOR BLESSING OTHERS.

In the days ahead, may we be taught by the Spirit to use our hands for His purposes. May God show us the areas where we have sinned with our hands so that we may determine not to do it again. Let our hands be holy, consecrated, and totally dedicated to the Lord and His work so that He will receive all the glory.

Sometimes, our portals to the spirit realm become blocked. We plug up the power that would normally move through us, stopping the flow. This can happen when we've had too much junk in relation to our hands for the healing flow to come forth. If that is the case with you, I'm not saying you have to do something so that God will love you more and therefore use you more. He already loves you as much as He could ever love you. But if you have sinned, you do need to be restored to Him, and you can be.

Do you believe that God is your Redeemer? Do you believe that He is your Restorer? Do you believe that He forgives you when you have made a mistake? I hope you do. These are all fruits of His great love. When, by faith, you grab hold of God's Word, receiving His forgiveness and restoration, it opens your blocked portals and lets the glory

flow freely again. God's power can flow into you, and it can also flow out through you.

When we dedicate our hands to God's purposes, not only can creative ideas come, but supernatural wonders can also happen. Jesus said we would lay hands on the sick, and they would recover. (See Mark 16:18.) This will not occur because of what we are able to do, but because we have made way for the Spirit of God to flow through us. We must make a way for His abundance to flow.

ABUNDANCE IS ACTIVATED BY FAITH

God's Spirit is inviting us to step into His realm of superabundance and enjoy its benefits, but as I said earlier, He will not force us to do so. We must determine, we must choose, to move into what God is offering us. Too many well-meaning Christians have said, "Well, if God wants me to have it, He'll bring it to me." Yes, God is sovereign, and there are moments in our lives when, in our inability to perceive, He shows up with His divine presence and brings us blessings, brings us abundance, brings us miracles, brings us breakthroughs. But the Bible declares in no uncertain terms that *"the righteous will live by faith"* (Romans 1:17 NIV). God can do it all, but He is looking for men and women who will rise up in faith and choose to move forward into every promise He has given. We may think we are waiting for Him to move, but He is often waiting for us to move in faith toward His promises!

Faith is not found just in the words we read or speak. Faith requires action, and faith produces action. When true faith is established in our hearts, we can no longer do the limiting, unproductive, even damaging things we used to do. Instead, we are given to doing the positive, fruitful, uplifting things that our faith dictates. We are given to living abundantly.

ABUNDANCE IS INITIATED BY SOWING

One of the primary actions of faith is "sowing." Galatians 6:7 delivers this powerful truth: *"Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap"* (NKJV).

It is easy to be deceived about the nature and role of God's abundance in our lives. The human mind is easily twisted. But supernatural abundance is something we cannot afford to be deceived about. Some people have the mistaken idea that the principle of sowing and reaping was only for another time in history and does not hold any real meaning for us as believers today. Well, to that, I say, "Look at the natural world, which often reflects the spiritual world: we still have farmers. Without them, we wouldn't have food to eat. Tell any farmer that you no longer believe in sowing and reaping, and they will be quick to reply that this principle does not only apply to some other era. It is actually very relevant today—in both the physical and spiritual realms. In fact, the principle of sowing and reaping is eternal."

A farmer who didn't believe in sowing and reaping would quickly go bankrupt. Moreover, every farmer knows that the specific seeds they sow in the ground will yield fully grown plants of the same type they have sowed. If the farmer wants to harvest pumpkins, he doesn't plant apple seeds but pumpkin seeds. We often lose sight of this reality in our spiritual lives (and even often in our natural lives): whatever we sow is what we will reap.

Some well-meaning Christians keep praying and praying, asking God why He doesn't seem to be moving in their finances, why He is not bringing them into abundance and increase. Why should He? They are reaping what they have sowed, and they have not been sowing financially. It is not enough to sow seeds of love or kindness and expect them to bring in a financial harvest, although that might happen at times. (See, for example, 1 Timothy 5:17–18.) A financial harvest will come from sowing financial seeds. A solid financial investment brings a good financial return.

I couldn't tell you this principle if I had not first practiced it myself in all areas of my life. I can affirm that what I am describing is not merely a theory or an idea that I heard someone else talking about. This is a principle that God has been teaching me since I was a teenager. When a miracle seed is deposited into miracle soil, it produces a miracle harvest in the life of the one who has sowed it.

It is time for you to begin sowing some miracle seeds and expecting a miracle harvest. We will talk more about how to do this as the

book progresses. Sow into the soil of God's glory, and He will send you a glory harvest!

Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up ["do not lose heart" NKJV]. (Galatians 6:8–9 NIV)

Whatever we do, we cannot lose heart. We cannot grow weary in doing good. What does this mean? It refers to persevering during the interval between the sowing of the seed and the reaping of the harvest. In the natural, the period of time between the planting in the spring and the harvesting in the fall is called *summer*. During a spiritual summertime, some people begin to wonder if anything is happening. I want to assure you that if you have done what God has spoken to you to do, you can know that He will accomplish what He has said He will do. If your seed has been placed in fertile soil, never doubt that your harvest is coming. Oh, it's coming!

ABUNDANCE IS CONTINGENT UPON HONORING THE LORD

The big picture of living in God's abundance also includes the understanding that we are to honor Him first with our wealth. Abundance is not all about us—it is about God's glory!

Let's look at two additional Scriptures that describe the abundant fruitfulness that God wants for us. The first is from the prophet Joel, who declared,

And the floors shall be full of wheat, and the vats shall overflow with wine and oil. (Joel 2:24)

I invite you to personalize this promise and say it this way: “My floors shall be full of wheat, and *my* vats shall overflow with wine and oil.”

God gives us His spiritual wine to fill our hearts with joy, and He gives us His anointing oil to make our faces shine. He is changing our countenances, making us the happiest of people as we rejoice in His presence and in His daily provision for us.

Second, the wise King Solomon wrote, “*So shall your storage places [“barns” NKJV] be filled with plenty, and your vats shall be overflowing with new wine*” (Proverbs 3:10 AMPC).

Let’s personalize this verse as well: “My storage places shall be filled with plenty, and *my* vats shall overflow with new wine.”

The passage in Proverbs where this verse is found comes with both a revelation and an instruction. Let’s read the verse that comes before it: “*Honor the Lord with your capital and sufficiency [from righteous labors] and with the firstfruits of all your income*” (Proverbs 3:9 AMPC). The *New Living Translation* says it this way: “*Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce.*”

What follows this act of honoring—full barns (representing storage places) and overflowing vats (representing containers such as bank accounts, wallets, or other items in which you hold abundance)—are the results of our obedience to the divine instruction.

How do we get to this place of abundance where we are filled and overflowing? Like most twenty-first century citizens of earth, we all want the plenty that this passage speaks of. We love the images of filled barns and overflowing vats. We welcome the wine and the oil. However, we often neglect to look more closely to see how this can be achieved. We frequently ignore the simple instruction that precedes it—and the two go together. You can’t have the one without the other.

The Scriptures are very clear on this point. The revelation is there for anyone who cares to seek it out. In faith, you can honor God with your wealth, and you should. And when you do, He will reward you bountifully.

At times, when I am preaching and say something like this, the room suddenly gets very quiet. In general, in modern society,

speaking about money is taboo. It's considered a private matter, and many people would rather not speak about it openly. Yet Jesus didn't have this outlook. He spoke very openly about money. In fact, He had a lot to say about finances. His teachings help us to understand that, in the hands of the right people, money can be a divine supernatural tool. Who are these right people? Those who choose to align themselves with God's purposes.

MONEY AND OUR HANDS

Previously, I mentioned dedicating our hands to the Lord. Our prayers concerning our hands must include the way we use our money. Now, don't get me wrong. Abundance is not all about money. Actually, it's mostly *not* about money, but how we handle our finances affects everything else in our lives.

For most of us, our hands and our money go together. We count our money with our hands. We take our debit card out and put it away with our hands. We write out checks with our hands. We use our hands to type on our smart phones or computers for online access to our bank statements and other records, to transfer funds to or from certain accounts, and to pay bills.

HOW WE HANDLE OUR FINANCES AFFECTS EVERYTHING ELSE IN OUR LIVES.

In the past, we may have used our money in ways that were not pleasing to God, ways that did not honor Him. I don't know about you, but I want to honor the Lord in everything I do!

For example, have you ever wanted to buy something for yourself, and while you were in the process of making that purchase, you realized that you shouldn't do it? That's not to say that what you were buying was bad. Still, you knew you shouldn't be buying it. The Holy Spirit within you was saying, "Stop!"

There might be various reasons why the Spirit would warn you in this way. For instance, perhaps He knew you would fall into difficulty

if you bought the item because you would be financially overextending yourself. If you couldn't pay your bills, it might affect your credit rating. If the Holy Spirit has told you He doesn't want you to go into debt, and you are charging whatever it is you want to buy, without being able to pay it off in full by the end of the monthly credit cycle, you are headed for trouble.

"Don't buy that," you sense the Spirit saying.

"But I really like it," your flesh replies. "There is nothing wrong with this. How could it be wrong?"

It's a good question. The answer is this: anything that goes against the voice of the Holy Spirit is sin. I know that might be a difficult pill for some people to swallow, but it's the truth. If you do or buy anything that goes against the voice of the Holy Spirit, you are living in disobedience. (See Ephesians 4:30.)

Surely, you would not want to live in disobedience to God. So, these are important issues.

I'm not just writing this for your benefit. I am speaking to myself as well. There have been times when I wanted something very badly, but I didn't have the money to buy it, so I thought, "Well, I can just pay for it with a credit card. After all, there's nothing wrong with it. It will be a blessing to others. It will be a blessing to my own family." And yet the Spirit was saying, "Don't do it. You don't need that. Don't buy it."

God knows what is best for you, so ask Him. Then, after He has spoken, obey what He says. He wants you to use your hands for righteousness and not for disobedience. And He has given you the ability to resist temptation (see 1 Corinthians 10:13) and to bring every thought captive to the obedience of Christ (see 2 Corinthians 10:5). God also gives you authority over every evil spirit, including the "spirit of mammon"—any demonic influence that would prompt you to elevate money to the place of God in your life. (See Matthew 6:24.)

Whenever money comes into our hands, we need to consult the Lord about what we are to do with it—and then do what we know is right. Asking God about using our money wisely is one of the ways we learn to hear His voice and obey His Spirit. It's also one of the ways we begin experiencing divine abundance.

PRIORITIZING OUR FINANCES

My friend Ryan Rufus of New Nature Ministries wrote a blog in which he offered some very sound advice concerning the godly stewardship of our finances. It shows us how to honor the Lord with our wealth. Here is an excerpt from that blog:

There are seven things that demand your money with every paycheck, and it is vital how you prioritize each one. Which should I pay first? Which should I pay last? How do I order everything in between?

This is how you should steward each paycheck. Each one is listed in order of priority:

1. Tithe/give/sow
2. Tax
3. Debt
4. Save
5. Bills
6. Necessities
7. Luxuries

If you divide up every paycheck into these seven areas and prioritize them in this order, you will eventually get out of debt and into abundance. This is how my wife and I order our finances, and it works! It may not work straightaway, but give it time and stick to it, and it will eventually start working for you.

The first four things should be done before you even spend a cent on anything else. Luxuries must absolutely always come last. This is essential. Only buy luxuries once you've taken care of all the other things and only if you have money left over. NEVER go into debt for luxuries!

Here is the problem, though: people often put luxuries first.... In fact, a lot of people order their spending in the exact opposite way than they should be doing, and their financial priority list ends up looking like this:

1. Luxuries
2. Necessities
3. Bills
4. Savings
5. Debts
6. Tax
7. Tithe/give/sow

The problem when you order it this way is that there is usually no money left after number 3, which means there's no chance of saving or paying debts or taxes—and giving to God is just impossible. If giving is last on your list, and you do somehow manage to have a little bit left at this point, can you imagine how hard it will be to give it?

The solution is so simple. Flip your budget over!

1. **Give first.** Put God first in your finances. This is the point where it's the easiest to give; but the longer you leave it, the harder it gets.
2. **Tax.** Put a little money aside from every paycheck into a separate account so it's there at tax time.
3. **Debts.** Put as much money as you can every paycheck toward paying off your debts so you can get rid of them as quickly as possible and not be overwhelmed by interest. Once your debts are cleared, your savings are going to rocket.
4. **Save.** Try to put some money aside in a savings account every paycheck, even a small amount. Over a few years, this adds up. And then spend savings mostly on assets rather than on liabilities. (Research the difference.)
5. **Bills.** Pay your bills as soon as you can, and try to limit them so you can free up money for savings and unexpected expenses.
6. **Necessities.** Know the difference between a necessity and a luxury. The problem is that people often convince themselves that luxuries are necessities. Food, transportation,

accommodation, medication, and basic clothing are necessities. Eating out at restaurants, buying new things, upgrading technology, vacations, and entertainment are all luxuries we crave—not absolute necessities.

7. Luxuries. There's nothing wrong with luxuries, but keep them last on the priority list.²

Again, to the righteous, money is a supernatural and strategic tool that can cause the kingdom of God to move forward and expand. But when placed in the hands of the wrong people, money is a dangerous weapon for the acceleration of the kingdom of darkness. I'm not just referring to money in the hands of "sinners." The same is true for money in the hands of believers who are not listening to the voice of the Spirit. That money can become a curse instead of the blessing God intended it to be.

Obedying the instructions in Proverbs 3:9, "*Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce*" (NLT), can mean all the difference in our lives. I need to honor the Lord with my finances, and you do too. This is a key principle. It is a major revelation of abundance. This is the Spirit's instruction: "*Honor the LORD.*"

We must honor the voice of the Holy Spirit, who lives within us and speaks to us so clearly every single day if we listen and discern His voice. If we honor that voice and honor the Lord through our finances, then the Bible says, "*So shall your storage places ["barns" NKJV] be filled with plenty, and your vats shall be overflowing with new wine*" (Proverbs 3:10 AMPC). Hallelujah!

ABUNDANCE AND TRUE WORSHIP GO TOGETHER

The last (but certainly not least!) foundational biblical principle of abundance is that the true worship of God and increase go together. Whenever you honor the Lord, aligning yourself with Him and His purposes, living in His presence through heartfelt worship and a yielded heart, you can't help but be blessed. Worship leads you into the abundance of God's heart.

WORSHIP IN SPIRIT AND TRUTH

Jesus made it very clear to the Samaritan woman that the Father is looking for those who will worship Him *"in spirit and in truth."* (See John 4:23–24.) You cannot worship in truth unless you're worshipping in spirit because anything else is a false reality. When you worship in spirit, it's because you have received a revelation from God concerning worship and its power to change your life and circumstances.

Worshipping Him in spirit and truth will cause you to begin to feel His joy, His goodness, and His glory; then, in the midst of that glory, you will encounter the angels of heaven gathering to join you. This is because when you honor the Lord and move yourself into alignment with Him through worship, the angels are there to worship with you.

If you sing, *"Holy, holy, holy,"* you will join the song of heaven, which the angels are already singing (see, for example, Revelation 4:8), and you will find yourself encountering God in a new way. Your praise and worship will create a pathway for you to travel into God's divine presence. If you dance before the Lord, the angels will join in. Soon, Ezekiel's *"wheel within a wheel"* will be turning (see Ezekiel 1:16), and God will turn some negative things around for you.

Similarly, if you honor the Lord with your finances, if you honor the voice of the Holy Spirit in regard to the giving of your wealth, you will discover that there are angels of abundance moving in that supernatural realm, blessing you—and you will find that your giving has become a bridge for you to travel into the depths of God's goodness and supernatural provision.

Again, this Scripture from Proverbs 3 provides us with great revelation concerning our finances and the way we can honor the Lord

with our wealth through the correct stewardship of the bountiful provisions He has brought into our lives:

Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine. (Proverbs 3:9–10 NLT)

A MULTIMILLION-DOLLAR TESTIMONY

My dear friends Tony and Sandy Krishack are the pastors of Victory Christian Center, a wonderful Foursquare church in Houston, Texas. I've had the privilege of ministering at their church every year for more than fifteen years. Several years ago, the Lord spoke to Pastor Tony from Proverbs 3:9–10 and challenged him to obey it fully and to encourage his people to do the same and see what would happen. Pastor Tony was faithful to the vision and began encouraging his people to honor the Lord with their wealth.

He laid it all out before them in a simple way: First, there is the “stuff” we already have. This includes the blessings God has caused to come to us. Second, there is the promise: if we do the right thing with what we have, our barns will be filled with plenty and our vats will be bursting with wine. That’s the “stuff” we will receive. God is just waiting for us to release what we have so that He can bring us into the greater things He has promised.

Every Sunday, when Pastor Tony stood to receive the offering, just as the Lord had spoken to him, he shared Proverbs 3:9–10, encouraging the people to give of what they had in order to obtain what God had available for them, to give of their current “stuff” so they could receive all that He had promised. As you can imagine, things began to change for the better in the lives of the members of Victory Christian Center.

Each week, Pastor Tony invited people to come forward and testify about what they were experiencing. “I don’t want to know what your salary is or how much money you’re making on your job,” he told them. “I don’t want to know about any government checks you normally receive. What I’m interested in is the increase, the overflow, the abundance that comes to you. If you experience a supernatural debt reduction, I want to know about that. If you receive an unexpected

bonus at your job or an unexpected increase in salary, I want to know about it. If you have money come in unexpectedly from any unusual source, I want to know about it.”

Weekly, the testimonies began to come in, and Pastor Tony, who is a very organized person, wrote them all down. I love that about him. Even though he is open to moving in the Spirit, he is also an excellent administrator who does things in an orderly way. From the first day, he has kept track of the miracles and the abundance that have come to the members of that church since they entered into the revelation of Proverbs 3:9–10 and began obeying its instructions.

In the first three years and eleven months, those increases amounted to twenty-six million dollars. Is Victory Christian Center a megachurch with many thousands of members? No, it is a congregation of about four hundred people. Yet, together, they have received twenty-six million dollars in increases from the Lord. Why did this happen? Because they heard what God was saying, and they believed it and obeyed it. Honoring God, honoring the voice of the Spirit and being led by His voice, is the greatest key to entering into the unlimited abundance He has prepared for those of us who love Him and want to do His will.

ARE YOU READY TO RECEIVE?

In this chapter, we have looked at the “biblical big picture” of God’s abundance for us, setting the scene and laying the foundation for the rest of this book. Again, we need these establishing principles to be able to fully understand and apply the seven divine mysteries.

At the end of each divine mystery chapter, I have included prophetic decrees that will help you to put into action the faith that will build within you as you read about the specific mysteries. You will be enabled to make these decrees with complete confidence, knowing that God watches over His Word to perform it in your life. (See Jeremiah 1:12 AMP.) As you speak the decrees, you may feel that some of the statements resonate with you more strongly than others. This is okay. God is establishing His truth within you. Write down the ones that you feel most confident about and place them on a mirror, refrigerator door,

bulletin board, or anywhere else where you will see them often. These notes will remind you to speak the decrees on a daily basis.

If you want to move into a new realm of unlimited abundance in God, I encourage you to read on and to keep your heart open. Jesus said, *“I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows]”* (John 10:10 AMP). He was talking about you.

There is not a single area of your life for which God does not have a promise of victory. There is not one situation that you face for which God has not already established a way of overcoming for you in His Word. His abundance is at your disposal. Are you ready to learn how to receive it?
