AND IT CAME TO PASS!

A few years ago, I was in Houston, Texas, to preach for a three-day, Holy-Spirit revival on Easter weekend. From the moment I was invited to be the main speaker at this revival, I began a forty-day fast and prayed for the power of God to move in salvations and miracles. The final night of the conference was Easter Sunday; it was also the fortieth day of my fast. I was standing on the Word of God that He would be faithful to fulfill His promises and answer the prayers of the people who were there. Our God is a NOW God, and I knew He would move mightily through the people if they had the faith to believe Him. His Word would not return void or empty (see Isaiah 55:11); we would see His hand move on their behalf!

The final service on Sunday night had gone on for three hours and people were still waiting in line for prayer. "Lord," I prayed aloud, "we're not leaving until I have prayed for every single person who is looking to You for answered prayer!" Next in line was an eager family: a father, a

mother, and their three children. The parents wanted prayer for their nine-year-old son. The Spirit of the Lord began stirring in my spirit.

“Eric, please come over here,” I called. Eric Maczym was a church leader who had invited me for this weekend conference, and he was also videotaping the personal ministry. Still holding his camera, Eric joined me at the front of the prayer line. The little boy’s mother was explaining that her son had been born without a right ear. I could see just a little skin flap where his ear should have been, and he had no ear opening. His mom said her son didn’t have an eardrum in that right ear, either.

“Put your finger in his left ear, his good ear, so that he can’t hear anything,” I instructed the young mother. She did, and then I began calling out to the Lord to heal this little boy. Within minutes, a huge smile spread across his face; we knew the Holy Spirit was moving! His mother still had his good ear closed with her finger, so I spoke to the pastor beside me, “Whisper something in the boy’s missing ear.” He whispered and asked the boy to repeat his words. The youngster repeated the phrase, word for word! “Move further back and whisper something else,” I said. Again, the little boy repeated what the pastor had said, word for word! The congregation’s excitement was building; it was almost a roar as the Holy Spirit swept through us. Joyful shouts of “He can hear! He can hear!” echoed repeatedly around the room.

The atmosphere in the church became electric! This wasn’t just a onetime wave of glory passing by. A Holy-Ghost-powered atmosphere enveloped the church, and it stayed with us for the rest of the night. The congregation was on fire, praising and worshipping our miracle-working God!

“That Easter night I saw one of the greatest miracles in all my years serving ministries in the body of Christ,” Eric Maczym said. “That little boy—I will never forget his face. It was glowing! I will never forget being a part of this miracle, filming it up close. The boy was smiling and crying, ‘I can hear! I can hear!’ when he was on camera—and when he was off camera, that little guy was so excited, celebrating what Jesus had

done! From that moment forward, you could sense the Spirit moving in power. I had never experienced anything like it before. The impact it made on everyone who was there that night will be eternal.”

God spoke His Word on supernatural healing, *and it came to pass!*

THE FIVE MOST POWERFUL WORDS

In the early years of my ministry, the Holy Spirit revealed to me that the *five most powerful words* in the Bible are these: *And it came to pass*. What do these words mean? In the Scriptures, “*and it came to pass*” means that *something happened* JUST LIKE GOD SAID IT WOULD! God speaks His will in the Bible or through prophetic messages—and *then it comes to pass!* Satan hates the declaration “*and it came to pass*” because he knows how it charges up our faith and because he doesn’t want God’s will to be done on the earth.

The will of God is always done in heaven. But He also wants His will to come to pass on earth. “*Thy kingdom come, thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven*” (Matthew 6:10). Not my will. Not your will. His will. Even though I preach God’s Word and prophesy God’s words, it is still His will and not mine that should come to pass!

The angels shout their praises in heaven when God’s will comes to pass. We know that God’s will is for salvation—that all “*should not perish, but have everlasting life*” (John 3:16; see also 2 Peter 3:9). When people get saved, that is the will of God, and His angels shout, “And it came to pass!” We know that God’s will is for healing: “*With his [Jesus’s] stripes we are healed*” (Isaiah 53:5). When people get healed, that is the will of God, and His angels shout, “And it came to pass!” These words are proclaimed by the angels before the throne!

And it came to pass is a testimony of who Jesus is, what He has done, and what He is continuing to do in heaven and on earth. It is His character; it is His deity. You can’t read about Jesus in the gospels without seeing things come to pass. The blind see, the lame walk, the dead are

raised to life again. What God wills to be done *happens*; His words *come to pass*. And they bring glory to God!

“AND IT CAME TO PASS” MOMENTS

“And it came to pass”—*this is the ministry that the Lord has given me!* I *preach* His Word, *pray* for His will, *prophecy* in His name, and then have the faith that His will shall *come to pass* in the people around me. When God speaks through His Word or through prophecy, and then His will *happens* in our lives, I call those “and it came to pass” moments. By God’s grace, everywhere I go to minister the Word of God, there are always “and it came to pass” moments. I’ve never had a week go by when something hasn’t come to pass. In heaven, God’s will is carried out without question—it comes to pass. On earth, His will is carried out when we understand His Word and then believe it by faith—and then it comes to pass! Every Christian can experience this by having the faith to believe that God’s will shall come to pass for us.

I thank God that I have spent a lifetime experiencing the supernatural power of the living God. Because of His call, I have been blessed to move in prophecy since I was young girl. Prophecy is the testimony of Jesus and His words, not my own. God speaks to His people today through the prophetic gifts. He gives words that are His will, spoken through His Word or through prophecy, and then He brings those words to pass for His glory. That is when we have “and it came to pass” moments!

Christians need to have “and it came to pass” moments. “And it came to pass” are God’s power words, and the church needs them now! How long have you been in your church without seeing anything miraculous come to pass? The Word should be coming to pass as it is being preached. The Word should be coming to pass as it is spoken in prophecy. We need bold faith in the supernatural power of God’s words and His will to bring things to pass in our lives!

Wake up, church! Don't just say, "I'll just put that prophetic word on the shelf and see if it happens." No! You've got to take it by faith! You've got to take it by force! "*From the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force*" (Matthew 11:12). What takes the kingdom of heaven back in our lives is the power of the Holy Spirit—the resurrection power of Jesus Christ! Some of you have been waiting a long time for something to come to pass in your life. Well, it's time for that waiting game to stop. You should have an "and it came to pass" moment every week of your life!

FAITH.

How do we experience "and it came to pass" moments? With the God kind of faith. God wants you to have radical, supernatural faith—faith for miracles like the nine-year-old boy's healing for a new ear and other miraculous works that Jesus said would be greater than His own! "*He that believeth on me [has faith], the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father*" (John 14:12). Do you know what faith is? God gave me a special acronym to describe this kind of faith. F.A.I.T.H. is "Forsaking All I Take Him"! *Forsaking everything else in life, I take God as my source!* It's faith that is focused on Christ alone for the source of your life and not the false power of the world. You can't do anything without faith. You can't even obey God without faith!

Faith is not just a noun—it's an action word! Faith without works is dead. (See James 2:20 NKJV.) We need the faith that pleases almighty God. "*Without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him*" (Hebrews 11:6). Listen to those words. Without faith it is impossible to please the Lord our God. We need to have mighty, powerful faith that will not back down! God wants you to have the faith to shake hell. The devil should shudder every time you get out of bed! You have

anointed faith. Faith is how God blesses and accomplishes His will on earth. Faith is how “and it came to pass” moments happen!

Faith for miracles should be a part of your daily life as a Christian. I know it is for mine! It should be our very breath. Preaching the truth of God’s Word, along with signs and wonders following, brings revival. Revival brings souls to Christ for eternity! Signs and wonders are the *greater works* that Jesus spoke of. We should be expecting miracles and healings to happen every day. People in the church today are forsaking their faith for some easier form of the gospel. This falling away should not be happening! Come to God in faith, *expecting something from the Lord*, because if you come expecting nothing—you’ll receive nothing. We should be expecting God to be faithful to His Word so that “and it came to pass” moments will be manifested in the kingdom of God!

We must always remember that we serve a NOW God. He is not a God just of the past. He is a God of the NOW for us! “**Now faith** is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen” (Hebrews 11:1). We need to stand up for who God is and what He can do and is doing for those who believe God is the NOW God. “Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation” (2 Corinthians 6:2).

This is the time for NOW faith because we serve a NOW God! Hebrews chapter 11 talks about this NOW faith because our God is moving among us now, and He’s waiting for His glory to be done on earth as it is in heaven. When the Holy Spirit began speaking to me about our NOW God, He showed me that when you turn the letters around, the word N-O-W spells W-O-N. Our salvation, our lives, our eternal future—they have already been won by Jesus Christ through His death and resurrection. We serve the God of the living—not the God of the dead, the God of the NOW!

ENCOURAGEMENT IN THE SPIRIT

Brothers and sisters, I want to encourage you. My prayer is that this book on walking in prophecy with supernatural signs and wonders in my life and in my family's life will build your faith for God to move for you, so that you will experience "and it came to pass" moments. For some of you, those miracles have been long overdue. Look to the Lord Jesus; He has your answers. Trust the Lord that you are going to have a testimony. "Receive My anointing now," says the Lord. The NOW God is here with you! I pray for each of you to receive the release of the Holy Spirit from heaven. Join me to invite the Holy Spirit to fill you with Himself now, whether for the first time or as a refilling. Just reach out to Him with expectant faith!

Lord, in the name of Jesus, pour out Your Spirit on those who have faith in Your promises.
